II. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE A.

Payment of Reservation Fees

- Students planning to register for the Summer session, should pay the reservation fee of fresh USD 250 for undergraduate students or fresh USD 250 for graduate students which will be considered towards the tuition fees of the Summer session. This amount is not refundable in case the student decides not to register for courses or drops the courses after registering for them. If the course you plan to register for is cancelled after paying the reservation fee, you need to report to the Registrar's Office to request a refund.
- Students planning to register for the Fall semester, should pay fresh USD 250 reservation fee which will be considered towards the tuition fees of the Fall semester. This amount is not refundable in case the student decides not to register for courses or drops the courses after registering for them.
- These payments can be made starting April 2. The Cashier's Office will be open Monday to Friday from 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM and 1:30 PM to 4:30 PM. For inquiries regarding financial matters, you may email billing@haigazian.edu.lb.
 - The last day students can pay the reservation fee for the Fall semester, without incurring any late fees, is May 2.
 - The last day students can pay the reservation fee for the Summer session, without incurring any late fees, is April 23.

- Students who fail to register during the registration period will pay fresh USD 50 late registration fee.
- Graduate Program students working on their thesis should register for 399 every semester during which thesis/project writing is in process. The correct sequence (399A, 399B, 399C, 399D...) should be followed.
