GRADUATION EVENTS



How have you been formed by the university experience? Are you, are we, more fit for life?" said Dr. John Holdsworth, Executive Archdeacon of the Anglican Diocese of Cyprus and the Gulf, to the graduating class of 2019.

Dr. Holdsworth was the guest speaker at the Baccalaureate Service of Haigazian University, which took place on Sunday, the 19th of May 2019, in the First Armenian Evangelical Church, next to University campus, in the presence of a capacity audience of graduates, along with their families and friends.

In his keynote address entitled "Fitness for Life", Dr. Holdsworth focused on the concept of the "usefulness of University education", namely sharing the ideas of renowned theologian, Cardinal John Henry Newman, in his book titled "The Idea of a University". Holdsworth put particular emphasis on the notion of "formation", which helps personalities and characters develop, and eventually serve communities. In this respect, he said, "formation has two elements: connectedness and humanity. Connectedness leads to real evidence of learning maturity by being able to see how different insights from different fields of learning relate to each other and to experience." Holdsworth also described the concept of "humanness" in modern ways as "emotional intelligence", focusing on the notions of self-awareness, self-criticism, the ability to listen, observe, reflect, empathize, respond appropriately to others, and to be able to read situations and people.

President of Haigazian University, Rev. Dr. Paul Haidostian addressed the graduates, emphasizing on the notion of "gratitude".

"Haigazian University was established to create a scholarly community of gratitude, so that our best academic preparation, alongside our community spirit, may lead us to refine the lives of those around us with our professionalism and sincere attitude," said Haidostian. Dividing the human feelings into two main parts, greed versus gratitude, Haidostian invited the fresh graduates to "go and create communities, families, companies, labs, schools, businesses, or neighborhoods of gratitude wherever you may be, and bring honor to God Almighty, yourself and your alma mater."

Many graduating students brought their participation in this solemn ceremony of dedication and thanksaivina: Assadour Manirian offered the Call to worship; Stephanie Arslanian, Nairy Masserlian and Mariana Khaiadourian read passages from the Old and New Testament. Sara El Haddad reflected on her University years. Neiteh Bodroumian performed an Armenian song "Kezme I Zad". Talented musicians. Saghdeiian Vahan and Ohanes Ashekyan played instrumental music by Mendelssohn, while Sarkis Yacoubian performed a piece entitled "Palenie".

carrying the light of truth, freedom and service to the world, and paused for the traditional group photo with President Haidostian.



59THCOMMENCEMENT CEREMONY



Haigazian University held its 59th commencement exercises, on Friday, May 24th, 2019, in a beautiful atmosphere of joy, pride and ovation, sometimes mixed with moments of high emotion. 130 bachelor and master degrees were conferred to undergraduates and graduates in the Faculties of Business Administration and Economics, Social and Behavioral Sciences, Humanities and Sciences.

Minister of Tourism Avedis Guidanian was there to represent both the President of the Republic Gen. Michel Aoun and the President of the Council of Ministers Saad Hariri, Member of Parliament Hagop Pakradounian represented the Speaker of the Parliament Nabih Berry. Among the attendees were Minister of Social Affairs. Richard Kouyoumjian representing the Head of the Lebanese Forces Dr. Samir Geagea, Member of Parliament Gen. Jean Talouzian. Prelate of the Armenian Catholic Patriarchy, Bishop George Assadourian, and international businessman and entrepreneur Rouben Vardanyan. The capacity audience also included a host of representatives of the Lebanese Army, Armenian and Lebanese political parties, religious leaders, Armenian and foreign diplomats, members of the Board of Trustees, community leaders, and representatives of educational institutions, parents, relatives and friends.

The auspicious ceremony started on the notes of the traditional Pomp and Circumstance by Sir Edward Elgar, whereby faculty proceeded with the celebratory processional march in their traditional academic regalia of caps, gown and hoods, followed by graduates. After the Lebanese National Anthem, the prayer of invocation was offered by Campus Minister, Rev. Wilbert Van Saane.

Expressing his pride in the graduating class, University President Paul Haidostian acknowledged the unwavering efforts and dedication of the parents, asking the audience to give them a hearty applause.

In his address, Haidostian thoroughly tackled the notion of "higher education", and all the challenges related thereto. "Higher education is not mainly the status, that is above others, but rather a higher understanding of matters, a higher degree of personal refinement, a higher level of understanding of the world and its underpinnings, a higher ability for adjustment in times of change, a higher appreciation for the weak, a higher admiration for the more experienced, a higher ambition to develop, a higher acceptance of one's own limitations, and a higher respect for the other", Haidostian said.

He went further to explain the feeling of "estrangement" associated with higher education, while the eventual purpose of it is to have the educated "feel at home".In this respect, he invited all graduates to "to continue searching for the heights, while seeking to feel at home with your mind and soul, and with those who surround you."

Haidostian concluded his speech by reiterating the ongoing mission of Haigazian University during the past 64 years in being "the home for the estranged on many levels", asking the graduates to "wherever they go help people feel at home intellectually, spiritually, and physically".

In her inspiring keynote speech, the Representative of the UNHCR in Lebanon, Ms. Mireille Girard addressed the graduating class by sharing her past experiences and insights within the United Nations. Girard engaged the fresh graduates to examine their options for the future, and encouraged them to make choices that will contribute to the common good and to actively commit themselves to work towards prosperity and exchanges among people and communities - choices that in the long run will not only lead to personal fulfilment, but also positively impact their wider environment and contribute to a more cohesive and peaceful world.

Girard concluded her speech by giving a hearty advice, saying, "today, as you are graduating and starting your voyage through life, you have two paths ahead: One that is to focus on the development of a fulfilling career, working your way up to your highest professional expectations - and this is a perfectly legitimate choice. But the other one is to do so by continuously keeping in mind - in everything that you do and undertake that sense of common good, upholding the values that the diverse and rich culture of the Levant has fostered so uniquely. It might be a more challenging path, but it is surely worth it."

The graduates then were called to collect their diplomas from the University President, helped by the deans Fadi Asrawi and Arda Ekmekji.



With a sense of pride and accomplishment, valedictory Ohanes Ashekian and Mohamad Al Atat expressed their deep gratitude to all the parents, University faculty and staff, acknowledging all their efforts and investment in shaping and equipping them to embark on their new phase of life. Speaking to their peers, Ashekian also wanted to thank his fellow graduates, saying "let's thank one



another for creating strong bonds that have played a great role in the gradual process of our growth." He further shared the main values he acquired at Haigazian University, that of "tolerance, respect, kindness and empathy". The Launching of the 37th Volume of the Haigazian Armenological Review

On Thursday, October 5, 2017, the 37th volume of the Haigazian Armenological Review was launched in Lebanon in the Haigazian University Auditorium in the presence of Rev. Megerditch Karagoezian, Armenian intellectuals, scholars, Armenian Studies students and a host of guests.

Fr. Antranig Granian, the editor-in-chief of the Review had passed away a few days earlier. Father Granian had joined the Haigazian University faculty in 1969. In 1991 he was appointed chief editor of the Review. During the past two and a half decades the Review had gained in experience, further enriched its content, strengthened its quality, and broadened its geographic space.



After an homage to the late editor, Fr. Granian and his involvement in the Review through a power point, the ceremony started with the opening words of the chair of the Armenian Department, Dr. Nanor Karageozian, who had joined the editorial board the previous year. Dr. Karageozian noted that "working together with scholars and experts of diverse fields and disciplines and editing the volume from multiple approaches are necessary tools particularly for the enhancement of Armenian Studies, which further grows through multidisciplinary efforts, perspectives and communications. Dr. Karageozian presented the content of the 724-page volume.

The cultural attaché of the embassy of the Republic of Armenia, Dr. Vladimir Boghossian, took to the podium and drew a panoramic picture of the Armenian studies efforts conducted in different corners of the world. Dr. Boghossian underlined that "as a scientific discipline and a constituent element of state policy, Armenian Studies becomes pivotal in the context of state formation of both the republics of Armenia and Artsakh."

The President of Haigazian University, Rev. Dr. Paul Haidostian, commemorated Father Granian and noted that his presence had "an ennobling, supporting impact on all of us. His presence encouraged us and made us more Armenian, urged us to work harder." Dr. Haidostian noted that the sphere of Armenian Studies is a part of the mission of Haigazian University, because "Armenian Studies is a science and generally speaking, science contributes to the growth of the Armenians. He stressed that universities and contemporary civilizations cannot generate thinking and curriculum as well as knowledge which is in line with current issues without research and research centers. Dr. Haidostian concluded that the Review has become the main address in attracting scholars who publish research papers in Western Armenian.

International Conference on "Armenians of Egypt, Sudan and Ethiopia"

Unlike the previous conferences, this conference was held in two stages: Cairo (April 12 & 13), in collaboration with the Diocese of the Armenian Apostolic Church of Egypt and Haigazian University (May 29 & 30). During the ten sessions panelists from Egypt, Lebanon, the United States, the United Kingdom, Sweden, Germany, France and the Republic of Armenia, presented a total of 38 papers.

Organized by the Armenian Diaspora Research Center at Haigazian University, this conference was the fifth of a series of annual conferences. All but the first conferences were supported by the Armenian Communities Department of the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation.

On Tuesday, May 29, the official opening took place in the presence of the prelate of Lebanon, Rev. Nishan Bakalian, community leaders from Egypt and Lebanon, Armenian intellectuals, historians, and academicians. The ceremony began with the opening words of Dr. Antranik Dakessian, Director of the ADRC. Rev. Dr. Paul Haidostian's words were followed by the introduction of the guest speaker, Dr. Ruben Adalian (Director of the Armenian National Institute, Washington DC). Dr. Adalian's lecture was titled "By the Nile and the sea, the currents and tides of modernity and the role of the Armenian Diaspora of Northeast Africa". The seven sessions of the conference were consecutively moderated by Drs. Arda Ekmekji, Nanor Karageozian, Archalouyse Topalian, Armen Urneshlian, Antranik Dakessian, and Shaghig Khudaverdian and Yeghia Tashjian.

An evening lecture was held on Tuesday. Vartkes Nalbandian, a veteran of the Ethiopian Armenian community lectured on "The Ethiopian Armenian community: Its past and present".

The Haigazian University Armenian Diaspora Research Center has scheduled its next conference on "Armenians of Greece and Cyprus" for May 2019.

More than 100 attendees actively participated in interactive presentations, workshops and discussions.



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SPIRITUAL LIFE

The Spiritual Life group at Haigazian University is a community of students who look for growth in faith and fellowship. Spiritual Life is affiliated with the Student Life Department at Haigazian University. All students are welcome to join spiritual life activities of their choice.

In the academic year 2018-2019 about twenty students were involved in the spiritual life group on a regular basis. Many others joined occasionally. The group was led by the campus minister, Rev Wilbert van Saane.
